

Initiative to Meet Objective


Develop a full compliance plan based on the university strategic goals and input from the monthly meetings with compliance officials from across the campus.


Created a two-minute video to be displayed on residential, classroom and cafeteria screens to allow the entire campus to learn about compliance.


Establish a group to meet with compliance officers from institutions in our Tier and all UNC system institutions.

Thru the Society for Corporate Compliance & Excellence, the compliance manager will be certified as a CCEP.








On March 18th, certification was achieved and the only certified compliance officer in UNC system.

Strengths

We have the only certified compliance officer in the UNC system institution.
We have an active and very dedicated compliance committee that meets monthly.

Opportunities

- Starting an HBCU group with compliance officers as we all face the same issues.
- Taking Compliance on the road and conducting compliance related trainings to each department.





Weaknesses

- Lack of attendance by all departments despite monthly invitations.
- Resources to implement compliance trainings to entire campus.
- Lack of internal controls across multiple departments.

Threats

- Compliance is a department of one.
- Not being included on audit prep and audit exit conferences.
- Departments continuing to operate in their own silos which are devoid of compliance activities.

Implementing Full Compliance & Risk Plan

 Now that we have a full compliance plan and appropriate KPIs to work on, we will begin the work! We will add homework for each department to work on to ensure compliance is being discussed not just with our workgroup but in each department. We will also create mini-workgroups to work with each department on our 2024 risk register. We must begin to mitigate each risks to reduce the likelihood of occurrence as well as causing reputational or financial damage to the agency.
