

The Men's Achievement Center

- The goal of the MAC is to increase the enrollment and graduation rate for all male students at NCCU.
- Five Programs
 - African-American Male Initiative (AAMI)- 135 students
 - Latino Male Initiative (LMI)- 18 students
 - Brothers of the MAC- 52 students
 - Sisters of the MAC- 74 students
 - African Brothers Alliance (ABA)- 12 students
- Overall Program GPA 3.04
- Fall 2023 Retention Rate-89% (NCCU-72%)

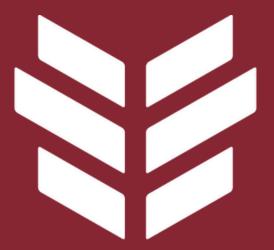
